

Immanuel - God with Us (Matthew 1:23)

BIRTH OF JESUS

- Angel of the Lord appears to Joseph in a dream (Matt 1:20)

- Joseph and Mary flee to Egypt with Jesus

JOHN THE BAPTIST

- Preached in the wilderness in Judea (Matt 3:1)

JESUS BAPTISED

JESUS FEEDS THE MULTITUDE

JESUS FEEDS 5,000 WITH 5 LOAVES AND 2 FISH

- Matthew 14:13-21
- With just 5 loaves of bread and 2 fish, Jesus blessed the food and gave them to the disciples.
- The disciples gave it to the crowd and once they had all eaten, they have 12 baskets full of left over

JESUS FEEDS 4,000 WITH 7 LOAVES AND FEW FISH

- Matthew 15:32-39
- With seven loaves and few small fish, Jesus feeds a crowd of 4,000.
- After the crowd had eaten, they had seven baskets full of left over

THE TRANSFIGURATION

Jesus went up a high mountain with Peter, James and John.

Here Jesus was shining like a sun and He was white light a light.

Along with Jesus appeared Moses and Elijah.



Then the voice of God is heard from the cloud, saying, This is my beloved Son with whom I am well pleased, listen to Him. Matthew 17:5

FAITH THE SIZE OF A MUSTARD SEED

The disciples are unable to free a demon possessed boy and bring him to Jesus, who sets him free. Jesus explains, that even faith as small as a mustard seed can move mountains. (Matthew 17:20)
