



# Jesus Christ is Sinless

### (Chapters 7 & 8)

- Questions arise whether Jesus is the Christ.
- The story of the woman caught in adultery reveals Jesus as the only sinless One among men, in Chapter 8.
- I AM the light of the world



- You are of this world; I am not of this world. **verse 23**
- If you abide in my word, you are truly my disciples. **verse 31**
- You will know the truth and the truth will set you free. **verse 32**
- So if the Son sets you free, you will be free indeed. **verse 36**
- If God were your Father, you would love me, for I came from God. verse 42
- Before Abraham was, I AM. verse

# Powerful explanation of a Healing

- Jesus heals the blind man's eyes on Sabbath day, which was frowned upon by the Jews
- Jesus reveals Himself as the Son of Man to the blind man

### I AM the Good Shepherd

Jesus sets forth a great example of how well the sheep know its shepherd, and obeys his voice. Jesus also declares that He is the door of the sheep.

### One with The Father

- I and the Father are One (Verse 30)
- Understand that the Father is in Me and I am in the Father (Verse 38)

## I Am The Resurrection & Life

(Chapter 11&12)

Jesus said, I am the resurrection and the life. Whoever believes in me, though he die, yet shall he live. John 11:25

## I Am The Way (Chapter 13&14)

Chapter 13 begins with Jesus teaching an important lesson on humbling oneself and loving one another - a new commandment He taught in verse 34. He sets an example by washing the feet of His disciples with water and teaches them to do the same to others.

This Chapter teaches us the importance of abiding in Gods Word. When we abide in Jesus He prunes us so we grow more abundantly. We did not choose Him, yet He chose us to go and bear fruit.


